Context

Improve the skills and capacities of vocational education and training (VET) professionals to provide better training and encourage learner participation in isolated rural/remote areas of the EU.

VETgoesRURAL: Improving access to VET in rural areas



- 1. Research, mapping and analysis of the main barriers and motivations for participation in VET activities in rural areas.
- 2. Educational suite incorporating new teaching and training strategies and tools for VET providers.
- 3. Design, pilot testing and fine-tuning of an e-learning course for VET providers.
