Context: Italy



- Need to reconvert economic sectors in rural environments.
- Abandonment of spaces, buildings and villages.
- Migration of young people to cities.

2 Target group



Young people from rural environments who want to undertake and reconvert rural areas into employment and life opportunities.

Goal: Activating entrepreneurship through the reconversion of rural spaces



Promote employment and entrepreneurship in European rural areas by increasing the capacity of young people to reconvert empty spaces into co-workings and occupational centers, through methodologies that transfer skills for sustainable entrepreneurship.

stablishment of coworkings through training



- 1. Identification of territorial potential, employment trends and skill gaps.
- 2. "Co-worker start-upper" training program for the management of coworking spaces with entrepreneurship module for different activity sectors

Collaborative methodology



The project is the result of a strong partnership, implemented by 7 partners in 6 EU countries with multiple skills and areas of expertise. It also involved local agents who participated in the research phase.

The learning methodology was blended, online through a digital platform, and face-to-face in existing abandoned spaces. Young people were prepared to design real business models and prototypes that could be implemented and transferred at the EU level.
